Blessings and much love to you all. As we all adjust to rapidly evolving guidelines from the CDC and federal, state, and local authorities, we want to continue to walk through this crisis together and provide event updates, as promised.

With disappointment but concern for everyone's safety, and mirroring the college's decision to cancel the May/June events of commencement and reunion, we have cancelled or postponed in-person WCLA events through June. Where possible, we have created remote events to maintain our connections.

- Spring Welcome Tea for Admitted Students There will be a Virtual Admitted Student Reception using Zoom. This event is co-hosted with Wellesley-in-Pasadena and the Wellesley Club of San Diego. A panel of alums will share their own experience and take questions from students and parents. There will then be a general session so any alum can share. - **Volunteering** To support our alumnae connections while we are in this season of Shelter-in-Place, we are launching a **Community Connections Initiative** which was inspired by the Washington Wellesley Club's example. 


